Many entries on the National Heritage List for England are brief and out of date. [Enriching the List](#) is a virtual volunteering project launched by Historic England to share images and insights of England's special places, and capture them for future generations.

The Putney Society is formally registered to submit additional content.

What can you share? Facts not opinion!

- Photos - new or old *4 per entry*
- Historical events and social history
- Later changes since a building was listed
- Information about the architecture or archaeology

ENRICHING THE LIST - FURTHER INFORMATION

Contributions must be concise, relevant and polite. They should

- relate only to a particular entry on the List;
- not be defamatory, offensive, vexatious or unlawful;
- not infringe anyone else's rights (including intellectual and privacy rights);
- not include personal information about any living third party; and
- not promote or further any business activities or with a view to commercial and/or personal gain.

FAQs

Information about the interior or exterior of a building?

Information about a building could include both the exterior and the interior.

Information about people and events associated with a building or site?

Historic interest related to people or events is an important part of listing, so please do include this information where relevant.

Cars in photographs?

Cars can obscure the building you are trying to photograph so should be avoided but it can be hard to do this in an urban area. If there are cars in your photograph (unless it's an old image) *please don't include readable number plates.*

Links to external websites?

Include full website addresses to external material within your text where there is additional information published online such as a report, historic photograph or record in another database. This is particularly useful for linking to resources from local archives or local Historic Environment Records. It is also useful to include references to other published material not available online such as books.

Link to other related entries in the list?

Where there is a connection or a useful comparison with another list entry please mention the List Entry Number.

Include information about how to help a building or site?

No, however this information may be of use to HE's [Heritage at Risk project](#).

Include photos? Can they include people?

Please do include photos of the entry, either general photos or to illustrate a particular point. Up to 4 photos can be submitted each time. Photos of people are acceptable, but try to avoid close-ups of people. *In such cases individuals should not be identifiable.*

Permission from the building owner to take photos?

Photos must be taken from public land or public rights of way. If taken from private land then permission must have been explicitly granted by the owner for the photo.

Copyright for any photos uploaded?

The photo must be yours or if a historic image you must have the rights to upload it.

Collections of photos or images about a list entry?

The Historic England archive accepts donations relevant to its collecting remit.
