

What is it? Putney Society, a registered charity, is an amenity society. Since 1959, it has lobbied those responsible for our local amenities and environment – often successfully.

How it works **The Society has four panels *monitoring, responding and acting on local civic issues:***

- **Buildings Panel:** engages with, and, when necessary, challenges planning applications that are inconsistent with the character of our area including listed buildings and conservation areas.
- **Community Panel:** is concerned with the efficient delivery of public services (e.g. health, postal, and police services, recycling).
- **Open Spaces Panel:** aims to protect the commons, riverside and other local open spaces. It enhances these areas by various plantings.
- **Transport Panel:** looks at the needs of all travellers by road, rail and river, including cyclists and pedestrians. It studies traffic plans and road schemes as well as aircraft noise and pollution.

Meetings: Each panel meets monthly (these meetings are open to *all* our members). In addition panels organise regular meetings on topics of specific interest to the local community. These are open to members and their friends, and held at the Brewer Building, Church Square.

Executive Committee: drives the work of the Society forward - debating the monthly reports from Panel Convenors. Our representatives liaise with other groups within the Borough and across London on matters of wider importance.

What else? The Society organises **social, cultural and heritage events**. It runs a **blue plaques scheme** and has produced a **history** to the area, and an **audio guide of historic walks** (for the visually impaired). We send a **monthly bulletin** to all members. We **liaise** with other London bodies.

Why you? The Society has well over 1500 members: individuals/ households, businesses, schools and voluntary groups. New members bring new ideas and fresh enthusiasms. ***The bigger our membership, the greater our influence.***
